USGA rules will govern all play

Local Rules of Play

• Pace of Play: The pace of play for foursomes should be 4:00 Hours

If the hole in front of you is open, always allow a faster group to play through. Player Assistance Program is now in effect: The Ranger will have a FLAG system to assist players with pace of play. GREEN FLAG – Pace is O.K. YELLOW FLAG – Players are falling behind. RED FLAG – Players must speed up immediately and/or might be asked to pick up and proceed to the next hole.

Lateral Water Hazards are defined by Red paint/stakes.

In absence of red paint lines, red stakes and/or the maintained green grass edge will define the margin of the hazard.

All water is played as a lateral hazard.

Drop areas are available on holes # 5, 6, 10, 11, 13, 14, 16, 17.

Special Drop areas have been provided on holes 4, 5, 9, 13, 15 & 17. They are denoted by a black stake with a red top (which designates the center of the green). This particular stake is an indicator as to where to take relief and drop from the lateral hazard and/or cart path. Your drop will be determined by which side of the stake your ball entered in the lateral hazard and/or which side your ball rests on the cart path. LE. On hole #4 if your ball enters the lateral hazard on the right side of the stake you will drop in the designated drop area to the right of the stake.

Palmetto, Preserve & Waste Areas are to be played as a Lateral Water Hazard. In absence of Red paint lines and/ or stakes, the maintained Green Grass edge will act as the margin of the hazard. If line and stakes are both present, lines take precedence.

Player NOTICE: If your ball is in a palmetto/pine-straw/preserve area (The Hasard), player can NOT ground club or touch loose impediments.

In some cases when dropping from this condition, a player's ball comes to rest on a Cart Path. IF your 2 club length penalty drop places your ball, swing or stance on the cart path, (Concrete or dirt) player is entitled to go to the other side of path and drop the ball under Cart Path Drop of one club-length, no closer to hole. Otherwise there is a FREE DROP FROM ALL CART PATHS (Concrete or Gravel).

. Out of Bounds are defined by White lines/stakes.

A Ball Leaving Grandez: Property, on or near Public Roads is Out of Bounds. (Right of #2 and Left of #13, 14 and 15)

In addition, areas on the course where a yard meets the course is OB (Marked with White Stakes) Under no circumstance shall a ball be played from a resident's yard.



- Free relief may be taken from sprinkler head(s) in the line of play within 2 club-lengths of green "AND" 2 club-lengths of ball. Ball not on green must be lifted then "Dropped" at nearest point of relief, no closer to the hole, not on green or in a hazard.
- . If a ball strikes a 150 yard pole, player has the option to replay, or continue.
- . Embedded Ball rule is in effect through the green.

If your ball is embedded in its own pitch mark through the green, player is entitled to free relief.

- · Railroad ties are considered obstructions. Free relief from swing or stance.
- Stones in bunkers are moveable obstructions. Appendix 1-5
- Rules Question/Dispute: If a rules dispute does arise, play an alternate ball and count both scores.
 See golf staff after play.

Rain shelters/Restrooms (Ice Water) are located on # 6, # 9 & # 14

NOTICE: Grandezza does NOT have a weather warning system.
